## Call for Artists and Designer Makers

If you are living and or working in the Canterbury district, producing unusual original craft to a high standard then we need you!

**YOU** are invited to submit your work for selection for Bohemia, Canterbury's own arts, craft and gastro market. The market will provide selected artists, designers and makers from the district with an opportunity to exhibit and sell quality handmade work/goods to shoppers from Canterbury's popular bohemian area on the Kings Mile.

### Dates to remember:

- First Bohemia: **SATURDAY 23<sup>rd</sup> AUGUST 2008** (and every 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday in the month thereafter)
- Deadline to apply: **FRIDAY AUG 1<sup>st</sup> 2008 12 NOON**
- Successful applicants will be notified by: **FRIDAY 8<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2008**

### To qualify all entries must:

- Be handmade, and not imported.
- Show creative flair and originality
- Be produced to a very high standard
- Hold valid public liability insurance up to £5 million

Priority will be given to makers/artists who meet the standard from the Canterbury District. Craft workers from outside the region will also be considered.

### Selection process:

The selection panel will be made up of:

- Guest selector, artist and maker, Lorna Dallas-Conte
- A representative from the Kings Mile Traders Association

- A representative from Canterbury City Council Arts and Creative Development Team

- Enclose 3 or more (up to 6) visual representations of your work (e.g. slides, digital photographs, prints, jpegs)

## Terms and Conditions

- Only applications using the official form and received at the address/email specified will be considered.
- If selected you will be committing to Bohemia on 23<sup>rd</sup> August and must be willing to participate for every fourth Saturday market in the month thereafter.
- The decision of the selection panel is final.
- Only handmade goods by artists and makers will be considered. Imported jewellery and manufactured high street clothing and similar mass produced items will not be accepted.
- The organisers reserve the right to remove any items from the market that are not of the standard indicated in the application, or appear to originate from a designer-maker that has not been selected.
- Insurance - Each trader will be required to carry a minimum of £5 million public liability insurance. If your application is successful, a copy of your current insurance certificate will be requested by the market manager
- Insurance of work against loss or damage is at the artist's discretion and is the responsibility of the artist.
- Health and Safety, trading standards and any other legal issues relating to any produce sold at this event are entirely the responsibility of the selected artist, designer maker.
- The licence fee is **£30.00** per stall per day. If your application is successful, the Market manager will request payment of the licence fee on the day. **PLEASE DO NOT SEND ANY MONEY WITH THIS APPLICATION.**
- A 6 ft x 3 ft table top stall with canopy will be provided (set up and dismantled by market organisers)
- The hours of trading will be from 9.00am to 5.00pm on each market day
- All contributors will be expected to set up, dress and staff their table, handle their own sales and packaging
- All rubbish must be cleared away
- All work must have a price tag attached by the contributor.
- All selected contributors are expected to organize their own publicity materials such as business cards, post cards, price lists, and portfolio as appropriate to ensure that they are able to present themselves to potential buyers.
- The organisers reserve the right to change these terms and conditions at anytime
